

"Fulfilling Your Ministry": "Mini"-Presentations



I. Simply following orders (Matthew 20:16)

- --"Wanting to" rather than "having to"
- -- Just going through the motion


"Work without Hope draws nectar in a sieve, And Hope without an object cannot live."

II. "Seeing is believing" . . . or not (Matthew 20:17)

- Belief in Jesus as God incarnate \rightarrow active worship
- Belief in *only* empirical data → "Doubt" = indecisiveness
 ("Wembleying")

III. Institutional authority as blessed assurance (Matthew 20:18)
