The Parable of the Lost Sheep

The Problem: Human Sinfulness


²³ for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God(Romans 3:23)



God's Solution


¹⁶ "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

John 3:16 (ESV)



God's Solution

• ²³ for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, ²⁴ and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, ²⁵ whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith. (Romans 3:23-25 ESV)



Salvation is by God's Grace, not by Our Works

• *For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, *not a result of works, so that no one may boast. *10* For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. (Ephesians 2:8-10 ESV)

Who is this Jesus?

• ²⁶ Eight days later, his disciples were inside again, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." ²⁷ Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here, and see my hands; and put out your hand, and place it in my side. Do not disbelieve, but believe." ²⁸ Thomas answered him, "My Lord and my God!"

Already a Believer?

- ³I know you are enduring patiently and bearing up for my name's sake, and you have not grown weary. ⁴But I have this against you, that you have abandoned the love you had at first. (Revelation 2:3-4)
- 8 Other seeds fell on good soil and produced grain, some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. (Matthew 13:8)
- "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit in me" (Psalm 51:10)

"The Romans Road" to Salvation

- **1. The Human Problem** (Romans 3:10, 3:23, 6:23): God created human beings to be in a relationship with Him; however, our sinfulness (we all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God) separates us from God, who is holy.
- **2. Humanity's Hope in Christ** (Romans 5:8): God's only Son, Jesus Christ, died for us on the cross while we were still sinners, thus paying the price for our sins and enabling us to be reconciled to God
- **3. The Sinner's Response** (Romans 10:9-10, 10:13): Call out to Jesus, inviting Him into your heart by accepting Him as Lord and Savior of your life
- **4. The Result of Salvation** (Romans 5:1-2, 8:1): Through faith in Jesus Christ, sinners can enjoy peace with God, no longer being separated from God by sin.

Drawing Closer to God

- Acknowledge: God, I know that I am a sinner and that the wages of sin are death.
- **Believe:** I believe that you sent your Son, Jesus Christ, as a payment for my punishment.
- Commit: I declare that Jesus is my Lord and profess my faith for salvation through the death and resurrection of Jesus.
- **Give Thanks:** Thank you for your grace, forgiveness, peace, and gift of eternal life. Amen!
