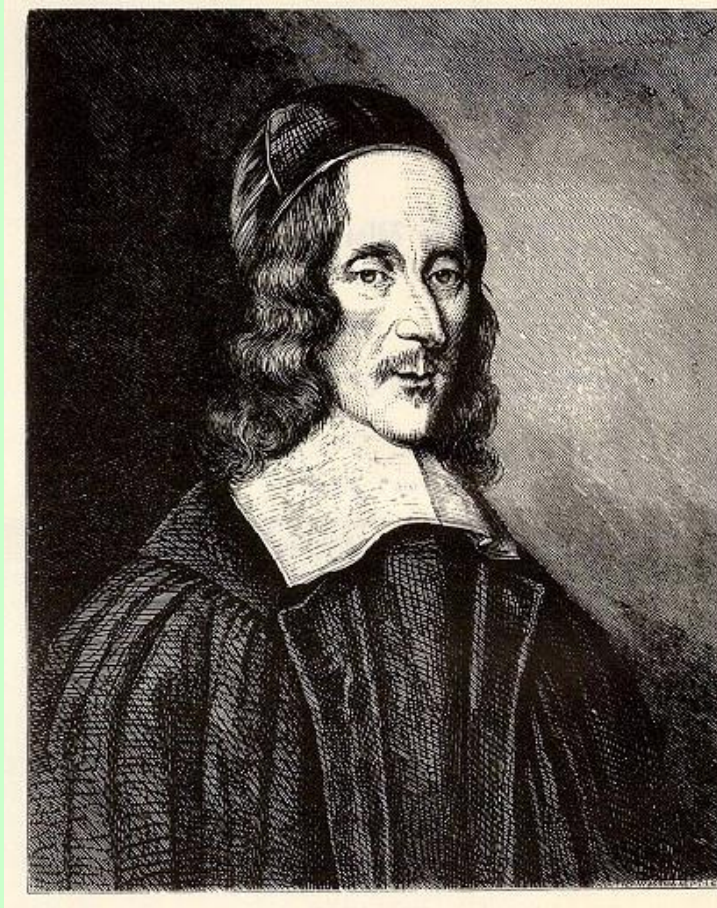

There is but one, and that one ever.

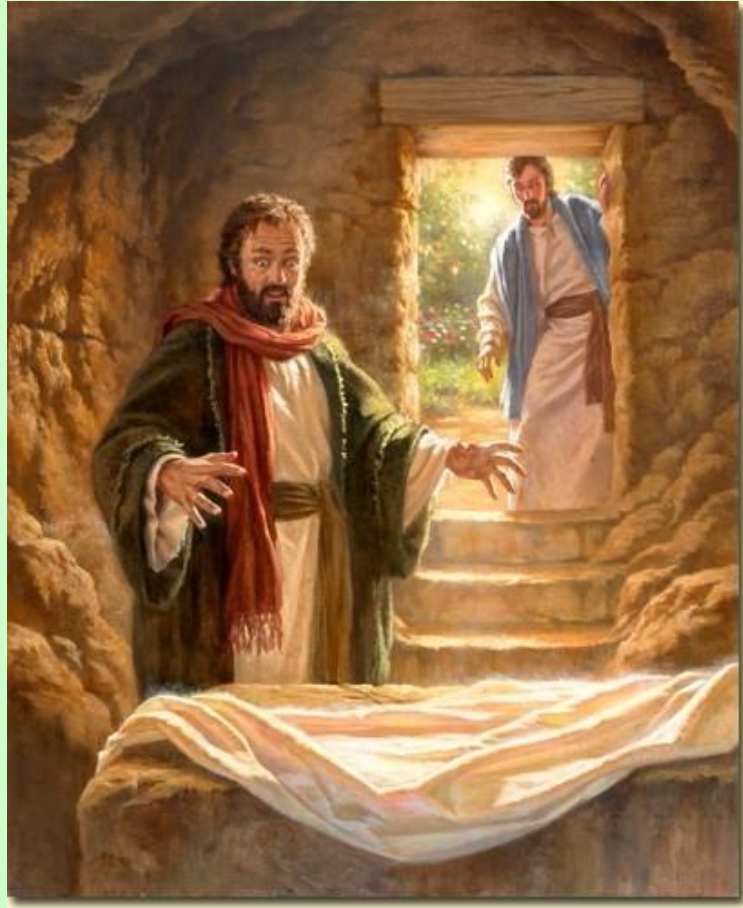
# The tomb and the stone (John 20:1)

# “Typology” defined

1 : (General meaning) study of or analysis or classification based on types or categories

**2 : (Biblical interpretation) a doctrine of theological types, especially one holding that things in Christian belief are prefigured or symbolized by things in the Old Testament.**

**A Christian form of biblical interpretation that proceeds on the assumption that God placed anticipations of Christ in the laws, events, and people of the Old Testament**

# The relationship between Jesus and his disciples

A new—even closer—relationship with Jesus (through the Holy Spirit) than when Jesus walked with them as flesh and blood:

--“my father and your father, my God and your God”(John 20: 17b)

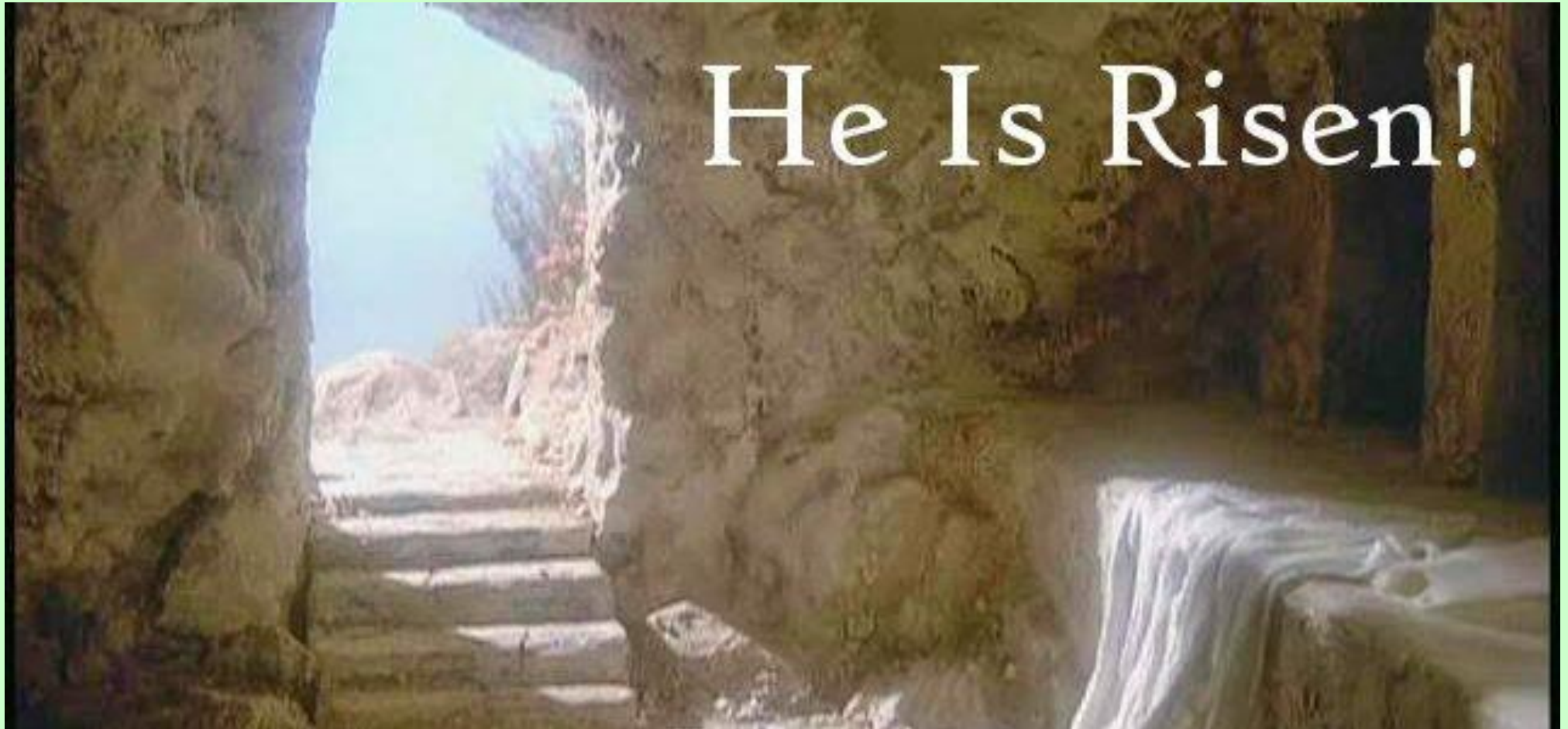
--The “Paraclete” = helper, advocate, Holy Spirit

--Jesus that night with the disciples: “And when he had said this he breathed on them and said to them, “Receive the Holy Spirit” (John 20: 22)
